<b>CBDD</b>	Coffee Bagel Donut Day (every Friday morning in the GSA office in South Silo)
<b>CRN</b>	Course Record Number (5-digit number assigned to specific class in specific quarter used to register for that class)
<b>DC</b>	Dining Commons (residence hall dining areas in Segundo, Tercero and Cuarto)
<b>ESL</b>	English as a Second Language (classes and services available to non-native English speaking students)
<b>FAQ</b>	Frequently Asked Questions (often listed on web sites to provide commonly needed information)
<b>GE</b>	General Education (required classes not specifically related to major)
<b>GPA</b>	Grade Point Average (calculated by Registrar every quarter, averaging grades received for all classes)
<b>GSA</b>	Graduate Student Association
<b>GSR</b>	Graduate Student Researcher
<b>I</b>	Incomplete (temporary grade given for class for which student has not completed all assignments)
<b>PELP</b>	Planned Educational Leave Program: Allows continuing registered students to suspend academic work.
<b>P/NP</b>	Pass/No Pass grade for a class (alternative to letter grade of A, B, C, D, etc.)
<b>PTA</b>	Permission to Add (a class, if you are late in registering)
<b>PTD</b>	Permission to Drop (a class)
<b>R</b>	Abbreviation for Thursday in course descriptions, to avoid confusion with Tuesday
<b>SID</b>	Student I.D. (9-digit number assigned to each student on entering UC Davis)
<b>SIS / SISWEB</b>	Student Information System website
<b>SPEAK Test</b>	A test designed to measure the fluency and pronunciation skills of non-native speakers' oral English; required for international students to become Teaching Assistants.
<b>TA</b>	Teaching Assistant (graduate student hired to assist professor with lectures, workshops, etc.)
